

HOME TIPS: Eavestroughs



As you have all noticed, autumn is well under way. Most of the trees have nearly finished shedding their leaves. I would like to take this opportunity to remind you to clean out your eavestroughs while the days are still relatively warm. This is also a good time to seal up any sections of eavestroughing which may be leaking. Cleaning out your eavestroughs promotes proper drainage of run off from your roof. This in turn will help to prevent ice damming and overflow.
